"I am the vine and ye are the branches" (John 15:5). This passage does not refer to the various denominations and community churches as branches, as so many teach and believe. That would conflict with all the above passages indicating there is one body. "If a man abide not in Me he is cast forth as a branch" (John 15:6). Jesus teaches the branches are individuals who must abide in the vine.

Scripture plainly reveals there is one church. The concept of attending the church of your choice is a false doctrine that perpetuates division. Serving God is my choice, but not how to serve Him. He is the authority and He commands how we serve Him. My role as His servant is to submit to His will. Rather than attending the church of my choice, I must attend with a congregation that faithfully observes HIS choices. 2 John 9 warns all of us: *"Anyone who goes too far and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God; the one who abides in the teaching, he has both the Father and the Son."*
